• Do you have a part-time job?

I fill shelves in a supermarket / work at the <u>cash register</u>... I <u>baby-sit</u> / look after children... I teach music... I help classmates with maths... <u>deliver leaflets</u>... help at sport events... <u>volunteer</u> in a home for <u>elderly</u> people / at a national park... assist handicapped people...

• What job / occupation do you want to do?

I hope to be / I would like to be / I want to become a businessman / businesswoman / hairdresser / tour guide / mechanic / shop assistant / engineer / doctor / nurse / cook / postman / banker / <u>bricklayer</u> / computer programmer / clerk (office worker) / teacher / farmer / waiter / driver / painter / secretary / police officer... I want to do something difficult / <u>challenging</u> / interesting / creative... help people / work on my own / work with people / animals...

• What is your dream job?

I dream about working as a... pilot / ballerina / pop singer / president / DJ / photographer / journalist / reporter / astronaut / singer / designer / scientist / banker / actor / film director... I would like to be a hockey / football / tennis player... detective...

• How do people find jobs?

First, it is important to... write / prepare... a <u>CV (curriculum vitae)</u> / with information about your education and past work <u>experience</u>. Then you can visit an <u>employment</u> <u>agency</u> which will find <u>suitable</u> jobs for you or you can look for job offers / ads... on the internet / in newspapers / magazines. When you apply for a job, send a <u>cover letter</u> and your CV / fill in an <u>application form</u> and wait to be invited to an interview.

• How to prepare for a job interview?

Find out some information about the company / employer. Dress <u>smartly</u>. Arrive on time. Don't be late. Remember the name of the person who is interviewing you. Be polite and friendly. Ask questions.

• What are the standard working conditions and benefits in the Czech Republic?

The standard / typical working hours in the Czech Republic are an 8-hour working day with 4 weeks of holiday, <u>sick pay</u> and a lunch break. You can get <u>lunch vouchers</u> / language classes / a company car / a phone / <u>gym</u> <u>memberships</u>.

• What different types of companies can you work for?

You can work for a small family company... a large multinational <u>corporation</u>... travel / translation / modelling agency / a <u>chain store</u> or <u>freelance</u>.

• Do you think that people will work more and more from home in the future?
